- **PAUL MENARD** will make his fourth NASCAR Sprint Cup Series start at Dover International Speedway this Sunday in the AAA 400.
- **MENARD AT DOVER...** In his previous starts, Menard has three top-25 finishes. His average start at Dover is 30.2; his average finish is 24th.
- **LAPS...** Menard has completed 1553 of 1600 (97.1%) of the laps he has attempted in Cup Series competition at the Monster Mile.
- **ON THE TRACK WITH ENERGIZER...** The No. 98 team will unload the Energizer / Menards Ford Fusion for this weekend's AAA 400 at Dover International Speedway.
