- **PAUL MENARD** will make his sixth NASCAR Sprint Cup Series start at Phoenix International Raceway this Sunday in the Checkers O'Reilly Auto Parts 500.
- **QUALIFYING AT PHOENIX...** Phoenix International Raceway is Menard's second-best qualifying track, averaging a 16.4 starting position. His best qualifying track is Kansas Speedway.
- **LAPS RECORDED AT PHOENIX...** Menard has completed 99.6% of the laps he has attempted in six Cup Series starts at Phoenix International Raceway (1,555 of 1,561 laps).
- **JOHNS MANVILLE RETURNS HOOD...** Long time sponsor, Johns Manville will return to the hood of the No. 98 Johns Manville / Menards Ford Fusion for this weekend's race at Phoenix International Raceway.
- **BACK TO NATIONWIDE IN PHOENIX...** Menard will be behind the wheel of the No. 98 Richmond / Menards Ford Fusion this weekend in the Nationwide Series race at PIR. In 14 NNS starts this season, Menard has recorded one top-five, four top-10 and 11 top-15 finishes.
- **PREVIOUS NATIONWIDE STARTS...** Menard has seven previous starts at Phoenix International Raceway in the Nationwide Series and has recorded four top-15 finishes.
